MINUTES OF APRIL 8, 2014

Meeting was called to order at 4:30 pm by Norman (Nope) Martin II, Chair

Mary moved to accept the minutes of March 25, 2014 as written. Nope seconded the motion and motion carried.

Highway Report: Randy reported that the 2012 Freightliner truck is at the garage with front end problems. New truck is also having front end problems and will go to garage after 2012 truck comes back. Reported "sink hole" on Dailey Hollow Road above Fancher Road turn. Car can get through but not trucks or large vehicles. Randy will notify the Fire Department and Woodstock Dispatch. Annual Financial Plan was reviewed and signed. Board reviewed and approved grant applications for paving the upper portion of the Bridgewater Center Road (\$111,000.) and to replace a culvert at the bottom of Bridgewater Hill (43,500), Randy will submit the paperwork to Agency of Transportation and town should hear about grant awards by June.

Treasurer's File: Payroll and order sheets were signed. A current budget status report was given to the board for review. Vicky noted that with board approval and pending hotel room availability, she and Bill would like to attend a Vision Appraisal training in CT from May 6-8th. Board approved.

Clerk's File: A liquor license was signed for the Back Behind Saloon. Excess weight permits were signed for Carleton Trucking, Noel Eastman, Bill Gault, Stanley Hill, Marlin Environmental, JB Webster and Arthur Whitcomb. Town has received information regarding the new Universal Recycling Law (Act 148) and that an informational meeting will be held in Hartland on April 17th. Nope and Nancy will attend. Working on updating the annual Emergency Operating Plan. Board was given copies of the draft which will be sent to Two Rivers Planning Commission for revisions next week. Will formally adopt at next meeting. Green Up Day is May 3rd. Bags are available for anyone wanting to participate before the 3rd and anyone interested should meet at the Town Office at 8:00 am on the 3rd. to coordinate pick up and collection routes.
