

BIDDING POLICY  
TOWN OF BRIDGEWATER

THE BRIDGEWATER SELECTBOARD MAY PUBLICLY ADVERTISE OR INVITE UP TO THREE BIDS FOR TOWN PROJECTS OR IMPROVEMENTS SUCH AS, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, SOUTHGATE HOUSE/WWTF MOWING AND GROUNDS UPKEEP, ROADSIDE MOWING, LANDFILL MOWING, ROAD AND BRIDGE CONSTRUCTION AND MAINTENANCE, ETC. THE BOARD RESERVES THE RIGHT TO ADVERTISE SUCH PROJECTS AS MULTI-YEAR CONTRACTS.

THE BOARD ALSO RESERVES THE RIGHT TO ENGAGE CONTRACTORS FOR OTHER PROJECTS, WHICH DUE TO IMMEDIATE OR EMERGENCY NEED OR THE TIME TO COMPLETE PROJECT IS A FACTOR, WITHOUT ADVERTISING FOR BIDS.

ANY PROJECT WHICH GOES OUT FOR BID MAY BE AWARDED TO ONE OF THE BIDDERS CONFORMING TO THE REQUIRED SPECIFICATION, WITH CONSIDERATION GIVEN TO QUANTITY OF MATERIALS, TIME REQUIRED FOR DELIVERY, PURPOSE FOR WHICH REQUIRED, COMPETENCY AND RESPONSIBILITY OF BIDDER AND HIS/HER ABILITY TO RENDER SATISFACTORY SERVICE. BIDS SHALL BE ISSUED AND RECEIVED THROUGH THE TOWN OFFICE. PROOF OF ADEQUATE INSURANCE COVERAGE IS REQUIRED.

THE SELECTBOARD OF THE TOWN OF BRIDGEWATER RESERVES THE RIGHT TO ACCEPT OR REJECT ANY AND ALL BIDS.
