MINTUES OF MARCH 25, 2014

Meeting was called to order at 4:30 pm by Norman (Nope) Martin II, Chair.

Mary moved to accept the minutes of March 11, 2014; John seconded the motion and motion carried.

Highway Report: New plow is expected to be delivered tomorrow (3/26/14). Randy has a meeting scheduled with VTRANS on March 31st. to review the grant applications and annual financial plan. Equipment all in good order and running.

Treasurer's File: Current expense order was signed.

Clerk's File: Liquor license applications were signed for Olson's General Store and Ramunto's. Excess weight permits were signed for Camp Precast, Ed Flynn, Harvey's Plumbing, Manning Pulpwood, Martin Exc., Miller Const. and Ottauquechee Well Drilling. Nancy will attend the Drug and Alcohol training seminar on April 22, 2014 in Rutland. April calendar given to the board.

Other business: The Bridgewater Fire Department has asked to use the recently purchased Ditto (13 Cram Trail) property for a training exercise. Training would include moving hoses throughout the house, laddering the building to practice victim removal and search and rescue during a simulated fire. This activity has been approved for the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program and the Town's insurance company. Mutual Aid fire departments may also be asked to participate. Training exercise would be held between April 12th. and 26th. Board approved the use of this building for the training activity.

Bruce Maxham updated the board on the planned painting of the outside of the Brick School House building. Historical Society is contracting with the Vermont Correctional Inmates, housed in Windsor to do the painting. They will power wash and prep building for painting. Will take 10 people approx. 3 days to do the job. Correctional Department carries their own liability insurance. Board was in agreement with this plan. A dumpster will be delivered on Wednesday at the Southgate House for cleanup of the basement and town offices.

Being no further business, motion was made and seconded to adjourn at 5:00 pm.
