MINUTES OF MAY 20, 2014

Meeting was called to order at 4:30 pm by Norman (Nope) Martin, Chair.

Nope moved to accept the minutes of May 6, 2014 as written. John seconded the motion and motion carried.

Highway Report: All trucks are back and in running order. Grading roads, replaced a culvert on the Oxbow Road. An access permit was reviewed and approved for Richard Ploof on the Barnard Chateauguay Road. Discussion of the ongoing water issue on the Bridgewater Center Road. Letter will be sent to the property owner requesting that a culvert be installed driveway ditched.

Treasurer's File: A current expense order sheet was signed. Delinquent tax and sewer accounts were reviewed. Delinquent Tax Collector, Joni Kennedy is in the process of contacting the mortgages companies on those accounts that have mortgages. She is also sending out demand payment letters before turning these accounts over to the attorney for tax sale proceedings. Board asked Vicky to send out "cut off" notices to 4 sewer accounts that have the longest delinquencies and highest balances.

Clerk's File: Excess weight permits were signed for Hutch Crane and JJ & Sons Logging. The delinquent dog warrant was reviewed and signed by the board. List will be sent to the town constable. The men's softball league will use the recreation field again this year. Games will be on Monday and Wednesday evenings beginning May 21st. to the middle of August. Lower end of the recreation field needs some lawn work. Will discuss in late summer. "Boat" also needs to be stained with a clear finish. Mary will follow up with a couple of painters. June calendar was reviewed. Meeting of June 10th. will be rescheduled to June 3rd.

New/Old business: Board re-adopted the Local Emergency Operating Plan since there was a change in Fire Dept. personnel. No action of the Transportation Advisory Committee representative, as meeting agenda's come in, Nancy will update board as to items that may be of interest to Bridgewater. Board was given a copy of the draft Hazard Mitigation Plan for Plymouth for review and comment.

Bridgewater will be working on a Hazard Plan later this summer.

New shelving has been built and installed and filled with storage boxes. Room has been cleaned and organized.

Being no further business, Mary moved to adjourn at 5:30 pm. Motion was seconded and carried.
