MINUTES OF OCTOBER 14, 2014

Meeting was called to order at 4:30 pm by Norman (Nope) Martin II, Chair

Visitors: Steve Selbo, Lynne Bertram and Virginia Dean, VT Standard

John moved to accept the minutes of September 30th. and October 2nd. as written. Mary seconded the motion and motion carried.

Visitors: Steve Selbo of SP Land Co. updated the board on the Killington Village Master Plan project located near the Grand Hotel in Killington. This project has been in the ACT 250 approval and appeal process since 2009. Bridgewater was given "Party Status" per a letter from the selectboard and planning commission, although no-one from Bridgewater actively participated in any of the hearings. Bridgewater's party status was questioned as the town boundaries are not directly adjacent to the Killington project. Steve asked the board to sign a letter to the VT Superior Court, Environmental Division requesting that Bridgewater's Party Status be withdrawn. Board agreed with this request and signed letter.

Highway Report: All vehicles are repaired and running. Currently working on bridge approaches in Chateauguay, driveway aprons on Baker Hill and doing some spot work on the North Bridgewater Road. Next project will be to take out the temporary bridge on the Barnard Chateauguay Rd. and replace it with a culvert. Sand has been ordered and will be arriving this week. Discussion of Road Project Program for the spring and summer of 2015. John and Randy have traveled most of the roads and have developed a project list by priority to include ditching, widening, mowing and brush cutting.

Nancy will work with Randy to get a bid notice ready for the mowing and brush cutting.

Nope mentioned that a culvert on the Bridgewater Hollow Rd. has been damaged, perhaps by a logging truck. Suggested that pictures be taken when making repair.

Treasurer's File: A current order sheet was reviewed and signed. The board was given a current status report.
