Meeting was called to order at 4:40 pm by Norman (Nope) Martin II, Chair

Discussion of warning a special town meeting to see if the legal voters wish to demolish the village school building as indicated at the informational meeting held last week. Would also need to warn for the election of a selectboard member to fill the unexpired term of John Timken until next March Town Meeting. Auditor has also recommended that if the town wishes to use the remaining fiscal year 15/16 school budgeted funds for future use of the building a vote should be taken to establish a reserve fund to allocate these remaining (approx. \$51,000) into. If reserve fund is not established, funds would be rolled into the next year's budget as a surplus.

Nope moved to warn for a special town meeting as soon as the 30 to 40 day warning period would allow to include an article to elect a selectboard member, establish a reserve fund and ask voters to demolish school building. Mary seconded the motion and motion carried. A Town Meeting will be warned for November 30<sup>th</sup>, at 6:30 pm.

Being no further business, the motion was made and seconded to adjourn at 5:45 pm.
