DOG LICENSES – All dogs, 6 months of age and older must be licensed on or before April 1st of each year. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, and the inability to hold rabies clinics, the Selectboard has waived the late fees for unlicensed dogs until May 28, 2020. At this time the rabies clinic scheduled for April 25th has been cancelled and we are working to get another clinic scheduled in May. IF your dog is current with its rabies vaccination, please send the fee of \$9.00 for altered and \$13.00 for un-altered to the town office and the license and tag will be returned to you by mail.
