BCA members reviewed the list prepared by Nancy and the checklist page by page per 17 V.S.A. 2150 and developed an amended list (see attached) of names that they felt should be challenged due to questionable residency status. Owen moved and Gloria seconded to authorize the clerk to send out challenge letters. Motion carried. Letters will be sent out to 51 people whose residency is being questioned. This process has to be completed as Notice of Completion of Biennial Purge of the Checklist has to be sent to the Sec. of State's Office by September 20th.
