

Hale Hollow Bridge # 28 Engineering & Design Project

Town of Bridgewater, VT

Hale Hollow Road TH-# 44

- I. **Project Description** – The Town of Bridgewater is seeking engineering services to perform an engineering evaluation of the stability of the stream channel and bridge at the location of Bridge 28 and to identify and assess damage caused to the bridge and site by the storm event of July 2023. This project will utilize federal funding from FEMA.

The report shall be completed by **August 15,2025**.

- II. **Project Background-** Bridge 28 is located on Town Highway #44 Hale Hollow Road over the Pinney Hollow Brook. Bridge 28 has a length of 34 feet and a clear span of 31 feet. The bridge roadway width (curb to curb) is 16.3 feet. The main structure is precast concrete T beams. During Tropical Storm Irene in 2010, one abutment was severely damaged by flooding and was replaced. During the storm event of 2023, flooding caused significant scouring behind the abutments. The VTRANS 09/21/2023 Bridge Inspection Report is attached.
