William called the meeting to order at 3:00 p.m. The gentleman that was scheduled to be here had sent an email earlier in the day that he had decided not to apply for the job. A second applicant that applied online did not reply to repeated attempts to come for an interview. William made a motion to recess the meeting until the site visit at 4:00 p.m. - seconded by George. Motion passed.

The Selectboard will convene at 2031 Bridgewater Center Road with the property owner for a site visit per her request at the October 24, 2023, Selectboard Meeting.

William reconvened the meeting at 4:00 p.m. at the site. Steve S. Tarleton and Deb Fish were also present at this time. Deb Fish was concerned about a portion of her property by the stand of trees on her bank that was left with a sheer drop after the work done in the river to repair the river to its former grade after the flood. Deb would be happy with just a couple loads of stone placed there. After some discussion – William had concerns about the town doing any work and /or providing material there as it would set a precedent. Further discussion ensued – Steve suggested just having some stone from across the river in the big gravel pile – that would not fit through the crusher brought over to her side to shore up the bank with one of the haul trucks. He would bring his own equipment and donate his time to fix the area – maybe in the Spring. William made a motion to bring 2-3 loads of stone from the gravel pile – for approximate 50' section of bank - seconded by George –motion passed.

Adjourn - Being no further business – William made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 4:30 p.m. – seconded by George.
