

TOWN OF BRIDGEWATER
SNOWMOBILE POLICY
2025-2026

The Selectboard of the Town of Bridgewater, County of Windsor, State of Vermont, hereby adopts the following policy:

All Class 2 and Class 3 Bridgewater Town Highways are CLOSED to snowmobile travel with the following exceptions:

TH # 5 CHATEAUGUAY ROAD (Merikaarto Bridge #33 to Barnard Chat. Rd)
TH # 6 BARNARD CHATEAUGUAY ROAD
TH # 45 BLANCHARD ROAD (local traffic only between 7:00 am – 10:00 pm)
FIRE STATION BRIDGE
TH # 35 BRALEY HILL ROAD (town portion only)
TH # 4 BRIDGEWATER HILL ROAD (Intersection of Labor Hill to Little Sherburne Rd)
TH # 16 BROWN ROAD
TH #46 CURTIS HOLLOW ROAD (Bridgewater portion)
TH # 4 DAILEY HOLLOW ROAD (From “Gorge Bridge” to Fancher Road)
TH# 33 FANCHER ROAD
TH # 15 GRANDMA’ AMS HILL ROAD
TH # 44 HALE HOLLOW ROAD (Bridgewater portion)
TH #14 LATHAM ROAD
TH #30 LITTLE SHERBURNE ROAD (Bridgewater portion)
TH # 67 MAPLE VALLEY ROAD
TH # 9 PERKINS ROAD
TH #65 RIVER ROAD (Landfill – local traffic only)
TH # 21 STEVENS ROAD (Bridgewater portion)
TH #20 OXBOW ROAD (Bridgewater portion)
SOUTHGATE ENTRANCE (east end) AND LOWER FIELD
SA #1 Bridgewater Center Oak Chapel Bridge (crossing from Braley Road to Oak Chapel Road)
TH #24 Baker Hill (Crossing from crossroad between Dailey Hollow Rd and Baker Hill Rd to Lower Martin access)

Snowmobiles using open Town Highways shall not exceed the posted speed limit or where there is no posted speed limit, the maximum speed allowed shall be 30 m.p.h.

These roads are open as per vote of the Bridgewater Selectboard on December 9, 2025. Permission to use is given with the understanding that these roads can be closed for cause at any time.
